2025 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

LITERACY

- Include certified school librarians as critical partners as the State continues significant
 investments in education and literacy to collaboratively work toward long-term solutions
 for all Hoosiers.
- Champion public libraries' role in providing life-long learning for all ages and barrier-free access to quality early literacy activities and programming, like storytime, for all community members.

PROTECTION OF THE FREEDOM TO READ

Oppose legislative proposals for censorship and the infringement on the freedom to read
or that criminalizes librarians while performing duties in alignment with the core tenets of
professional librarianship.

FUNDING & SUPPORT

INDIANA STATE LIBRARY (ISL) BUDGET

- Maintain the current ISL budget requests as it leads to the enhancement and improvement of library services throughout the state.
- Retain full funding for INSPIRE, the online trusted resource provided by the ISL, that
 provides free access to academic resources and workforce development/college
 readiness tools.
- Continue state funding for 50% of the cost of the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library providing access to a monthly free book for all Indiana children from birth-5th birthday. As of December 1, 2024, a total of 119,925 children are enrolled.

STABLE TAX STRUCTURE

- Maintain autonomous local control and governance of public libraries as independent taxing entities. Indiana libraries have continually shown good stewardship with taxpayer dollars.
- Recognize Hoosiers' desire for tax reform, and advocate for a sustainable and stable tax structure that continues to fund the vital services that public libraries provide: literacy, workforce and economic development, life-long learning and digital equity.

ACCESS

- Advocate universal broadband access for Hoosiers at home as libraries continue to provide public access to high-speed internet and combat the digital divide.
- Value the role Indiana libraries provide as a reliable resource for vital public services and information to improve Hoosiers' quality of life.
