

AISLE Indiana School Librarian of the Month

The Association of Indiana School Library Educators, AISLE, is working in partnership with Rosen to recognize a librarian for doing exemplary work in our profession of school librarianship. Rosen Publishing Group provides engaging print and digital resources aligned with curriculum since 1950. This generous award provides a set of Rosen Publishing print titles for the winner's school and a letter of recognition sent to the winner's administrators. ***AISLE will also feature the winner's program and work via the ILF newsletter, social media, and the Annual Conference.***

To begin this program, the award will be given out twice annually - once in the spring and once in the fall, with the hope of increasing the frequency in the future. If multiple submissions are submitted within the timeframe, the AISLE Board, led by the Past Chair, will vote on the recipient and consider best practices, innovation, programs others could learn from and replicate, impact, and library professionalism. Unselected nominations will be kept for consideration for eighteen months from the date of submission.

The goal of this award is to recognize AISLE members who have developed and led an impactful program, activity, or initiative in their school building or district; to spotlight wonderful programming happening in school libraries in Indiana; and to elevate the work that school librarians are doing in Indiana.

Guidelines:

- To receive the award, nominees must be: 1) a current member of AISLE, 2) a licensed school librarian in Indiana, and 3) a current school library professional in Indiana.
- AISLE members may nominate their own program or nominate another AISLE member.
- The active Chair and active Past Chair are not eligible for the award during their time in those positions.
- Only one set of Rosen publishing books per school can be awarded per school year.
- ***A school librarian can be featured multiple times, but only one award will be given per building while with the same librarian. So if a librarian serves multiple schools or moves schools, submissions could represent work from different buildings.***
